## ...From the Kyle-O-Gram...

### Head Table Protocol

The Presiding Officer is seated at the right of the lectern, or right of center. The ranking guest or speaker is seated at the right of the Presiding Officer. The Parliamentarian is seated at the left of the lectern, or left of center.

Other guests are seated by rank, alternately left and right of the Presiding Officer. If there are several guests, they may be placed between the officers.

The size of the Head Table will be determined by the size of the room. If space is limited, ranking guests may be seated at Reserved tables in front of the Head Table.

Those giving the invocation and presenting the

lectern, either at the Head Table or at the Reserved guest table.

Place Cards should be used at the Head Table and Reserved Guest Table. Persons seated at the Head Table should be informed in advance. Likewise, if you are usually seated at the Head Table and you will be unable to attend, the President should be notified in advance, so the seating arrangement may be adjusted to eliminate gaps.

If your District and/or Club has a State Officer, that Officer should always be seated at the Head Table for meals. Her State Office will determine her place. No one of lesser rank should be seated at the Head Table, while those of higher rank are not.

## Recipe of the Month: Fudgies

2 cups sugar  
1/2 cup milk  
1/2 stick butter  
3 tbspcocoa  
3 cups quick oats  
1/2 cup peanut butter  
1 tsp vanilla



Put sugar, milk, butter, and cocoa in pan and bring to boil. Boil 1 minute. Remove from heat and stir in peanut butter, oats, and vanilla. Stir well and drop by teaspoons on waxed paper on a tray or cookie sheet. I usually then put the cookie sheet in the fridge to cool.
