Q. Is it necessary to have a motion to remove one's motion?

A. Ordinarily, if a mover wishes to withdraw his or her motion, it is allowed by rule of the chairperson. However, to be parliamentary correct, it is necessary to conduct a vote to allow a motion to be withdrawn. If the vote passes, it cannot be reconsidered, that is, the motion is declared to be nonexistent.
